Students from Leiden University:

 University before 1 September! Without an active student registration at your home

TU Delft students:

- Make sure you have an active registration as a bachelor student for 2016-2017 at TU Delft **before 1 September 2016!** Without an active student registration at your home university before 1 September 2016 it is NOT possible to participate in the minor!
- You will be registered as a contract-/guest student at Leiden University by the exchange of your personal data from TU Delft to Leiden University. You do not need to undertake action yourself.

EUR students:

- Apply for the minor during the application period 1 May up until 31 May 2016 via Leiden University OR via TU Delft:
 - <u>via TU Delft</u>: first you have to register in Studielink and then you will have to fill in and send the online application form on the TU Delft minorsite (available from 1 May up until 31 May): http://studenten.tudelft.nl/en/students/education/minors/minors-for-external-students/.  - <u>via Leiden University:</u> you have to fill in and send the online application form that is available on the Leiden minorsite from 1 May up until 31 May 2016:

- After 31 May you can still apply via Leiden University but you will then only be accepted if
 there are spots left after the registration period for TU Delft and Leiden University students
 has ended (= after 15 August 2016). To apply after 31 May you can contact the study advisor

 instructions from her.

- Make sure you have an active registration as a bachelor student for 2016-2017 at EUR before
 1 September! Without an active student registration at your home university before 1
 September 2016 it is NOT possible to participate in the minor!
- <u>EUR students who have applied via TU Delft:</u> you will be registered as a guest student at TU Delft on the basis of your Studielink registration. You will be registered as a contract-/guest student at Leiden University by the exchange of your personal data from EUR to Leiden University. In this case, you do not need to undertake action yourself.
- EUR students who have applied via Leiden University: you will be registered as a contract/guest student at Leiden University on the basis of the online application form (until 31 May 2016) or after following the instructions of the study advisor (after 31 May 2016). You need to register as a guest student at TU Delft before 1 September 2016 through Studielink. There will be a print-screen available on the minorsite of TU Delft with instructions: http://studenten.tudelft.nl/en/students/education/minors/minors-for-external-students/. Other external students:

- **HBO student** applications are at this point in time not accepted.
- Regardless of whether you apply via TU Delft or Leiden University: TU Delft, Leiden University
 and EUR students always have priority over other external students. You will be notified
 about your placement after 15 August (TU Delft) or in August 2016 (Leiden University).
- Make sure you have an active registration as a bachelor student for 2016-2017 at your home university before 1 September! You will need a proof of payment tuition fee ("BBC") from your home university in order to be registered as a guest student at both TU Delft and Leiden University.
- External students who have applied via TU Delft: you will be registered as a guest student at TU Delft on the basis of your Studielink registration. You will be registered as a contract-/guest student at Leiden University by contacting the study advisor miss Tineke Choi directly: studieadviesbsk@fgga.leidenuniv.nl. You will receive further instructions from her.
- External students who have applied via Leiden University: you will be registered as a guest student at Leiden University on the basis of the instructions of the study advisor. You need to register as a guest student at TU Delft **before 1 September 2016** through Studielink. There

will be a print-screen available on the minorsite of TU Delft with instructions: http://studenten.tudelft.nl/en/students/education/minors/minors-for-external-students/. It would be best for students to also contact minors@tudelft.nl, and inform them that they are external students.
